Executive Summary

An online collaboration platform allows a group of people to have access to documents, manage them and upload new ones that will then be available to their collaborators. In the EVENTS project, such a platform has been setup since the beginning of the project, based on the free-to-use platform “Redmine” [1]. It is functional since the beginning of the project, and more than 50 people from the partners already have access to its contents and are also able to contribute.
